Geovation Accelerator Programme

Ordnance Survey and HM Land Registry have launched the Geovation Accelerator Programme for Autumn 2024.

The programme is a founder-friendly programme designed to help entrepreneurs build their business and help them solve real world challenges using geospatial and property data. The programme is built around startups, giving them what they need to grow their business, develop their minimum viable product, and prepare for investment. Up to £20,000 in equity-free funding, workshops, coaching and more is available.
