# **Digital Transformation Flexible Fund**

The Digital Transformation Flexible Fund (DTFF)aims to help small and micro businesses in Northern Ireland to invest in advanced digital technologies. It establishes a grant fund to support eligible businesses with investments in capital equipment that is critical to achieving their digital transformation ambitions.

The focus of the fund is on innovative and emerging technologies, such as:

- Smart environments and the Internet of Things (sensors)
- Simulation, process automation (Robotics) and additive manufacturing
- Big data and analytics
- Immersive technologies (AR, VR, MR, Haptics)
- · Artificial intelligence and machine learning
- Blockchain technologies and more

Funding is available between £5,000 and £20,000 ex VAT for an investment project. If eligible, the grant can fund up to 70% of the cost of the total value of a project. Applicants must match-fund a minimum of 30% of the overall project costs.

Expressions of Interest will be closing at 12 noon on Friday 12th July 2024.

As part of the BridgeAl programme, Science and Technology Facilities Council (STFC) Hartree Centre are offering Innovation Vouchers worth £5,000 and £15,000 for businesses in the construction, transport, agriculture, and creative industries.

These vouchers can be used to access expert technical support in data science and artificial technology (AI).

#### BridgeAl Innovation Vouchers - £5,000

The £5,000 voucher facilitates 8 to 10 days from technical experts in data science and Al technologies.

### **BridgeAl Innovation Vouchers - £15,000**

The £15,000 voucher facilitates between 24 and 31 days of support from technical experts in data science and artificial intelligence technologies.

Made Smarter Innovation - Smart Manufacturing Data Hub (SMDH) offers three different funding opportunities to support manufacturing small and medium-sized businesses (SMEs) on their smart manufacturing journey.

#### **Rapid Demonstrators**

Rapid Demonstrators aim to support SMEs with sensor installation, data analysis or similar to enable levelling-up the opportunities for SMEs to exceed and expand. Grant funding of up to £50,000 per project is available.

#### <u>Lighthouse Projects</u>

Lighthouses aim to develop already proven digital products and processes into readily accessible solutions which meet the needs of manufacturing SMEs. Grant funding of up to £150,000 is available per project.
