### **Transform Programme**

The Transform Programme is a University-Accredited Professional Development programme leading to an Advanced Certificate in Social Enterprise & Sustainability. The programme will commence in October 2024 and conclude with graduation in July 2025.

It will include 3 x university modules, multiple roadmapping workshops, 2 x leadership summits, suite of world-class guest speakers.

### **AI Tools for Education Competition**

Funded by the Department for Education, this competition aims to develop solutions which use generative artificial intelligence (AI) to support teachers with formative assessment, such as tracking student progress and providing feedback.

These tools support high quality education through evidence-based teaching and learning approaches and align with relevant standards such as the National Curriculum or Early Years Foundation Stages.

Projects can apply for funding ranging from £50,000 to £200,000, inclusive of VAT. Successful applicants will gain access to a library of educational content and code optimised for use with large language models.
